### Reimbursement Information

Most insurance companies have policies stating that they cover smell testing using the UPSIT® or other of Sensonics' smell tests, including the Brief Smell Identification Test® (BSIT®) & the Pocket Smell Test® (PST®), under **CPT code 92700**. Some companies also recognize use of the UPSIT® as medically necessary to differentiate Parkinson's disease from progressive supranuclear palsy and corticobasal degeneration. In addition, smell testing using the UPSIT® is recognized by some insurance companies as a way to identify olfactory dysfunction in cases of nasal obstruction. In this case, use of the UPSIT® is included under **CPT code 92512**.
